SISTA Intervention (Women of Color) – Jamaica/Far Rockaway

Responsibilities

- Conducts on-going needs assessment including a review of characteristics, statistics, and data to develop or design services that are specific, sensitive and culturally relevant to the target populations
- Conduct and coordinate peer outreach to target population in the venues, neighborhoods or areas where potential participants may congregate.
- Provide individual health education and risk reduction counseling
- Recruit, train and supervise peer educators.
- Conduct REP/DEBI group intervention (SISTA) targeting African American and Latina women in Jamaica and Southeast Queens
- Conduct community presentations to increase awareness of the program and promote recruitment into CDC and other intervention/activities.
- Delivery of CTR – OraQuick HIV Testing intervention.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date client/peer chart recordings for SISTA and CTR interventions.
- Submit weekly program and activity progress reporting.
- Other duties as assigned by direct supervisor and departmental director.

Minimum Qualifications

- Bachelors Degree in social science or health related field and one-year experience, or three to four years work or field related experience
- Some experience in staff supervision

- Sensitivity to cultural, ethnic, gender and sexually diverse communities and persons directly affected by substance use experience.
